## Dear Chairperson Umali:

This refers to House Bill No. 2319 or "An Act Enhancing Protection for Women Inmates Held in Jails and Correctional Facilities" filed by Representative Mauyag "Jun" Papandayan, Jr.

The Department of Social Welfare and Development supports the intention of the bill to improve the ratio of women reformation personnel to women detainees as a strategy to eliminate abuses mostly committed by male prison guards.

In line with this, we believe that other considerations may also be looked into by the Committee to improve the condition of women in detention facilities. These include the women detainees':

- 1. Physical and medical needs e.g. for monthly periods hygiene/sanitary kits; when pregnant nutrition requirements, ante- and post-natal care and procedures for restraint and transportation
- 2. Psychosocial needs e.g. support services if detainee has been subjected to gender-based violence or if she has child dependent concerns
- 3. Procedures on how the detainee will be handled, searched and transported in general

There is also added value if the assigned women reformation personnel will be exposed to gender-sensitivity trainings to be more responsive to the needs of women detainees.
