1. **Training on Positive Discipline in Everyday Parenting**, held on 17-21 October 2016 at Kimberly Hotel, Tagaytay City

The training was sponsored by Save the Children which was attended by LGU social workers and Pantawid staff of Valenzuela and Malabon Cities and Non-Government Organization (NGO) representatives.

The objective of the activity was to provide the parents with basic knowledge and understanding on positive discipline to improve healthy family relationships and reduce corporal punishment at home.
